


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Landscape of Petroleum Exploration in Africa

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SUPERVISORY MODEL FOR PHD STUDENTS

- Candidates are expected to present research proposal before admission
- · Regular contact on progress with supervisors.
- Every student is assigned to at least 2 supervisors for monitoring, counseling, mentorship and research guide throughout the period of the study
- · On completion of research work, candidate required to present thesis based on research outcome to (a) Departmental Graduate Studies Committee, (b) Faculty Graduate Board, (c) Graduate School, finally (d) oral examination before external examiner
- · Students are expected to take the required courses and present 3 seminars in their specialized areas
- · To qualify for Graduation, at least 2 journal papers in reputable academic journals should be published by student amidst other requirements
