Accessing subscription resources

- Access through IP authentication (physically within institution)
 - Access via Usernames and Passwords
 - Off-campus access through Virtual Private Network
- RSIF is supporting subscription of over **40,803 e-books** and **3,210 journals** for the 11 AHUs. The subscription is for Elsevier, Springer Nature and ProQuest databases as per institution's selected collection. Total usage as of July 2021 - **271,000 hits**
